Genesis of the variety:

Late Shri Manaram developed an improved and high yielding variety of onion through mass selection method from a local variety cultivated by his forefathers. In 1983, he found some onion bulb with bright pink colour. He worked hard for the development of the variety and in year 1993, he coined it as *Sanwaloda Selection*.

Salient features of the variety:

- Early maturing (100-115 days).
- Higher yield (40 tons/ha).
- Delicious taste.
- Require lesser irrigation.
- Tolerant to drought conditions.

- **Seed rate:** 10 kg/ha
- **Spacing:** 10 × 10 cm (R × P)
- **Irrigation required:** 5 to 6
- **Sowing time:** October –November
- **Maturity:** 90-100 days
- **Insect/disease:** White fly, Red Fly, fungus
- **Seedling treatment:** Antifungal agent
